The Call To Stewardship

Every baptized person belongs organically and integrally to the Body of Christ and, as such, are members of one another. When every member of the body works in harmony with the whole of the body, the Body of Christ is healthy. When members of the Body of Christ work against each other, the Body of Christ experiences illness.

The Body of Christ has also inferior and greater parts, each with his or her own gifts. God, the source of every good gift (James 1:17-18), bestows them not so much for personal use and gain. Rather, he blesses each baptized person with gifts toward the *edification* of the whole Body. Each and every member of a parish, young and old, therefore has a moral responsibility, guided by the law of selfless love, to use his or her gifts and talents in service toward the *edification* of the Body of Christ. This practice is rightly called *stewardship*.
